One of his renditions will be "Younger Than Springtime." **Chuck Pereau**, a retired Los Angeles fireman joins the musicians with his ukulele and the vocalists with his versatile voice which allows him to sing country ballads, show tunes, or operatic arias. Chuck has been active for 40 years, supporting orphans in three locations in Mexico. **Allan Couzens**, who plays the saxophone and sings such light-hearted songs as "Chattanooga Choo Choo" provides much of the musical preparation.

One of her songs will be "Dream." **Frank Buchanan**, always an exciting performer, has had a long career in movies, TV and radio. At the age of 96, he is the group's most "experienced" member. Years ago, he and Chuck Pereau worked at the same firehouse where Frank was known as the "Singing Fireman." Frank's colorful career includes years as a champion bowler (four 300 games). He received numerous commendations during his 28-year career as a fireman and hundreds of commendations for his volunteer work. Frank is also a member of the Kool Kats and will perform in their next show. In the August 31st Sunshine show, Frank will play the drum and sing several old favorites. **Allan Couzens**, tenor, was included in last week's article as a member of the "Full House Quintet." He plays the saxophone and sings popular songs. He also performs with several other groups including the Laguna Beach Concert Band. **Beverly Dumas** shares piano accompaniment for the group with Sunshine. One of her piano solos will be "Unforgettable." **Art Yanes**, bass guitarist, plays an integral part in the group's shows. He helps to provide the sustaining beat that enhances the music and supports the singers. Art is active in several other musical groups, including the Village String Band.
